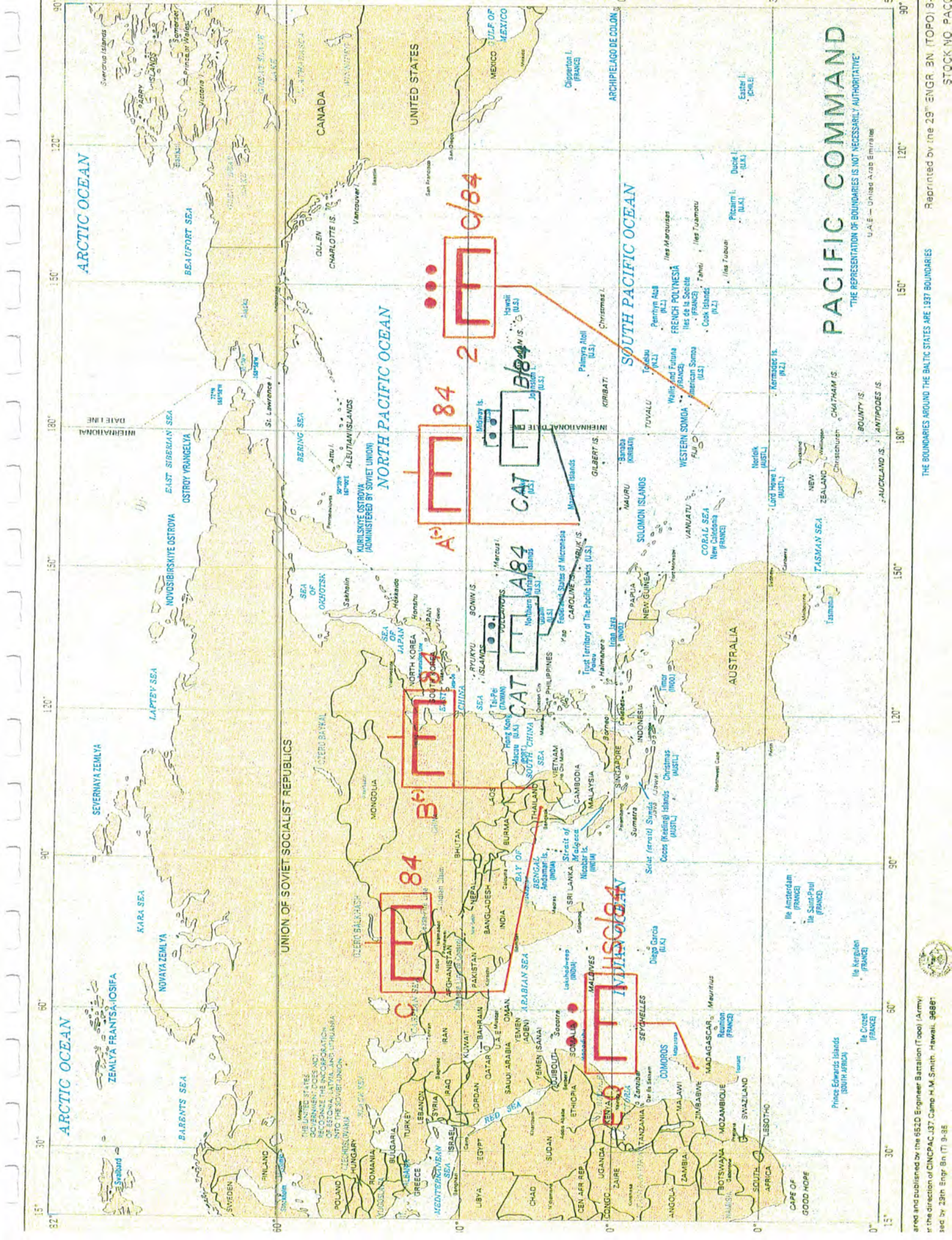

to include replacing a wooden bridge & installing 22 culverts.

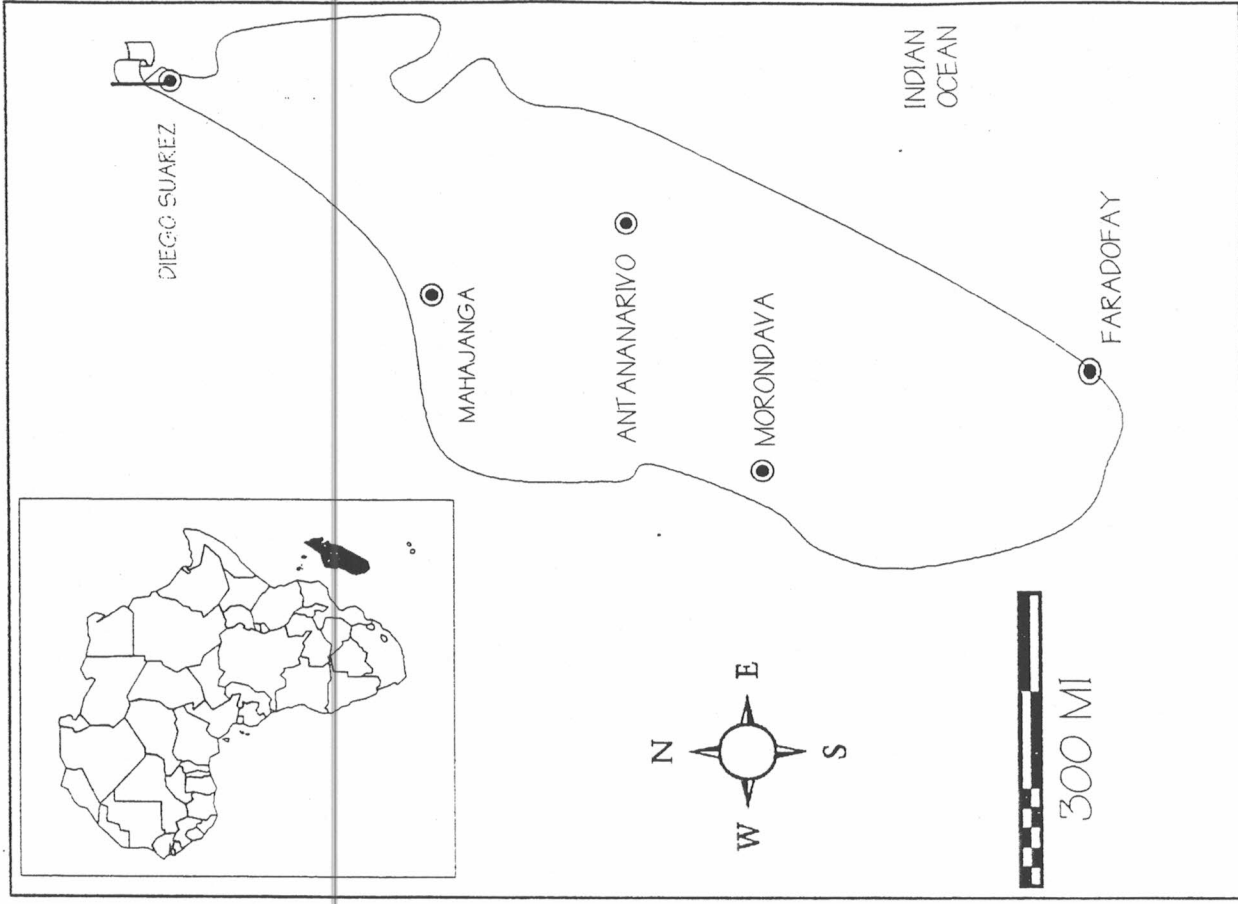

PROJECT TITLE: BAKER MASON IV

DESCRIPTION: 23 Km upgrade of single lane rural road
(i.e. ditching, shaping, compacting, & laying gravel surface)
to include installing 16 culverts.

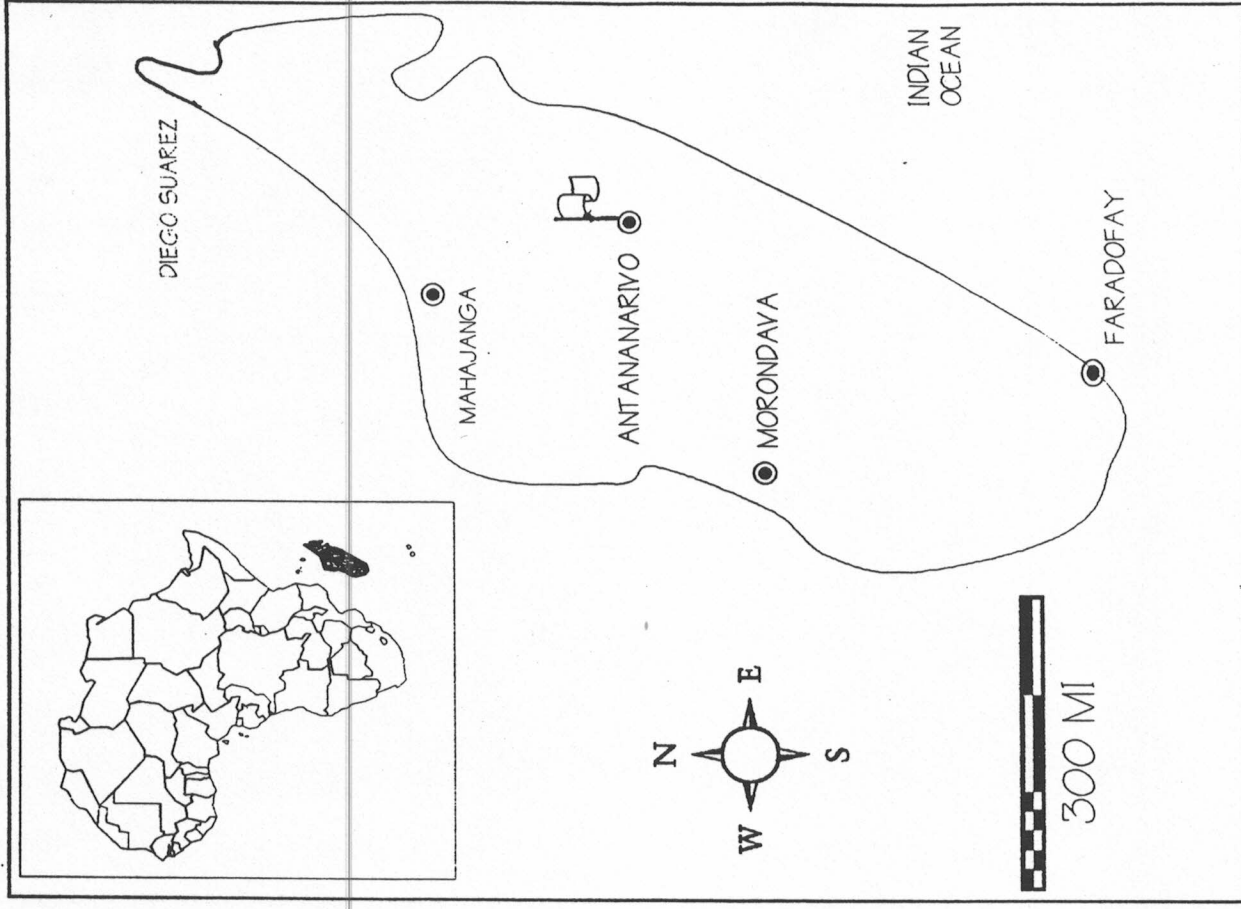

REMARKS: A site survey was completed in Feb 93. A 10 soldier team redeployed from Diego Suarez to Antananarivo, Madagascar to complete the second phase of a road upgrade. The 84th Engr Bn soldiers trained with 35 Malagasy soldiers from the 3rd Engineer Regiment.

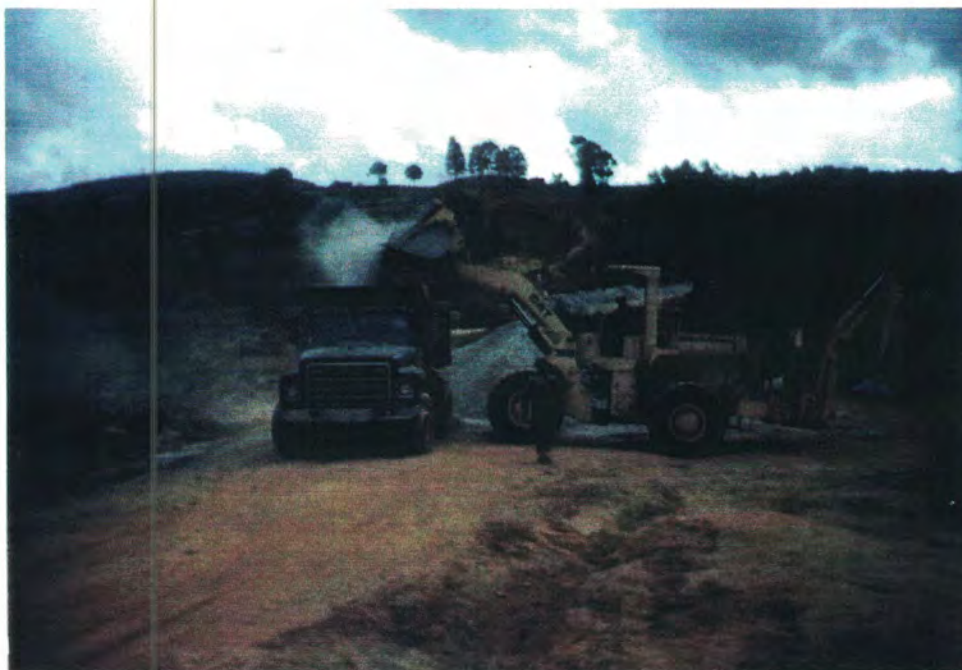

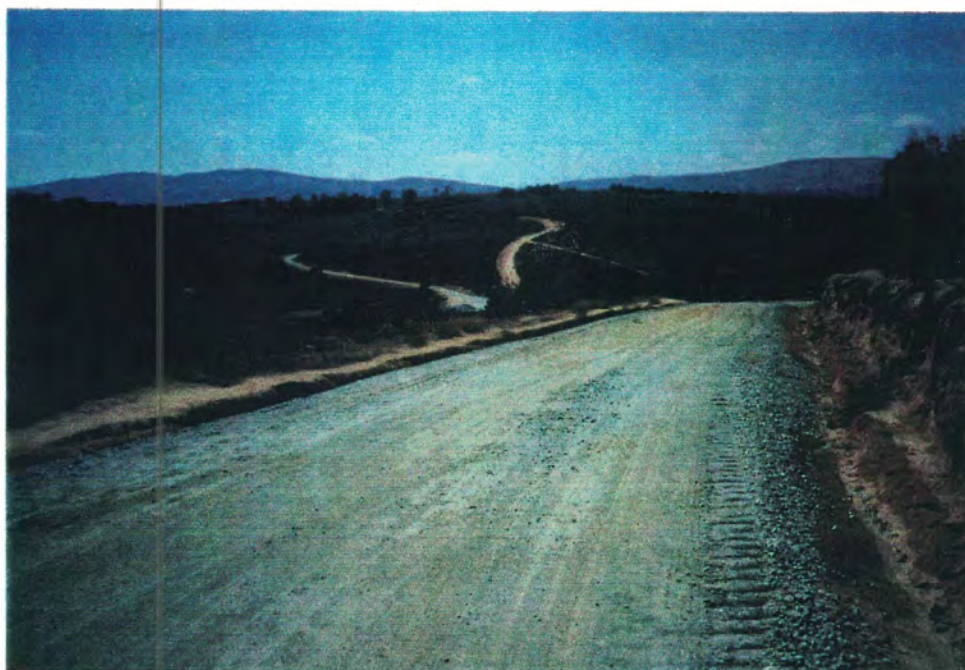

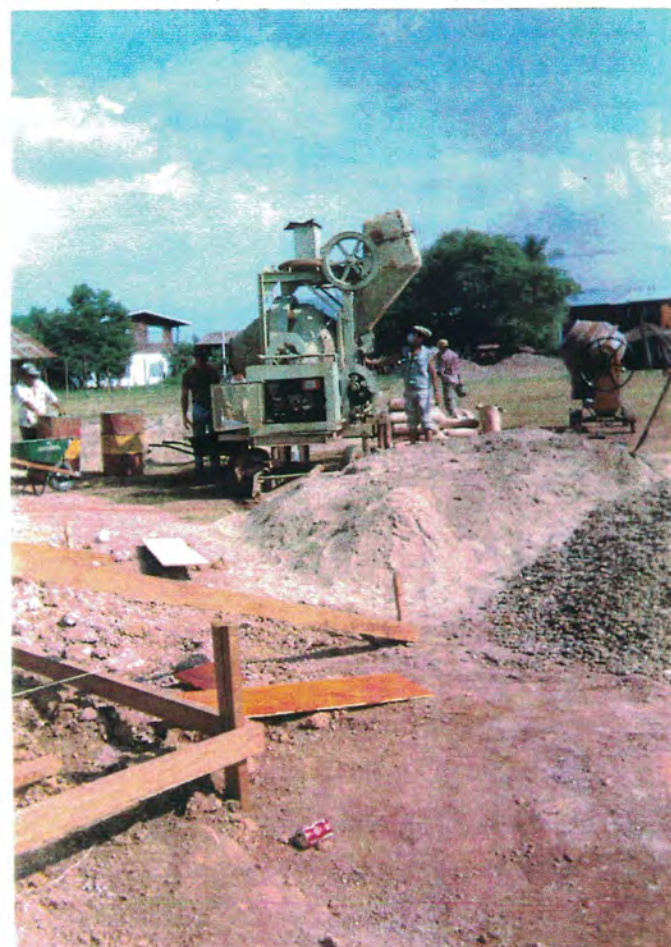

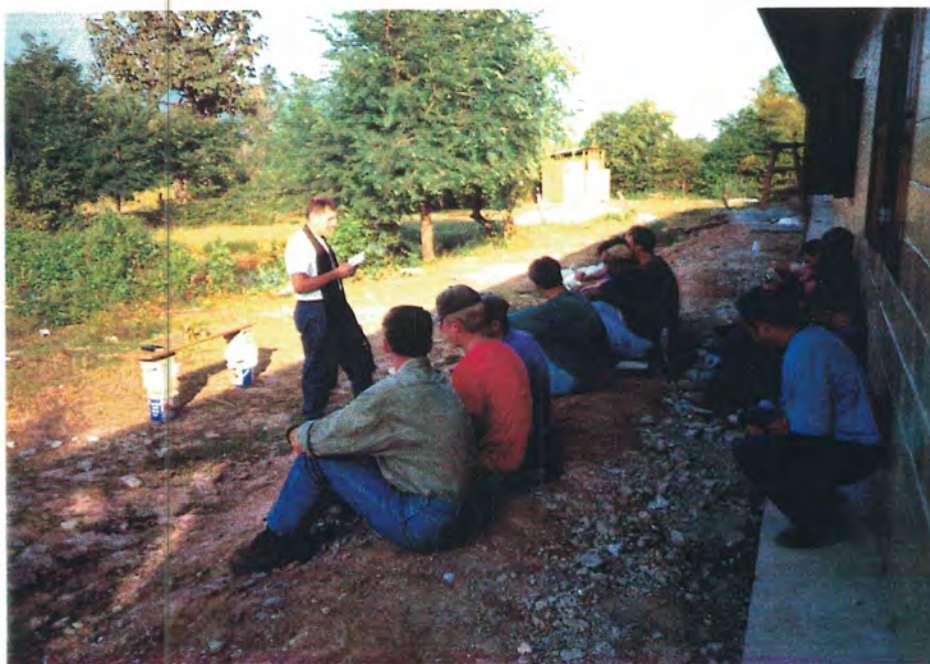

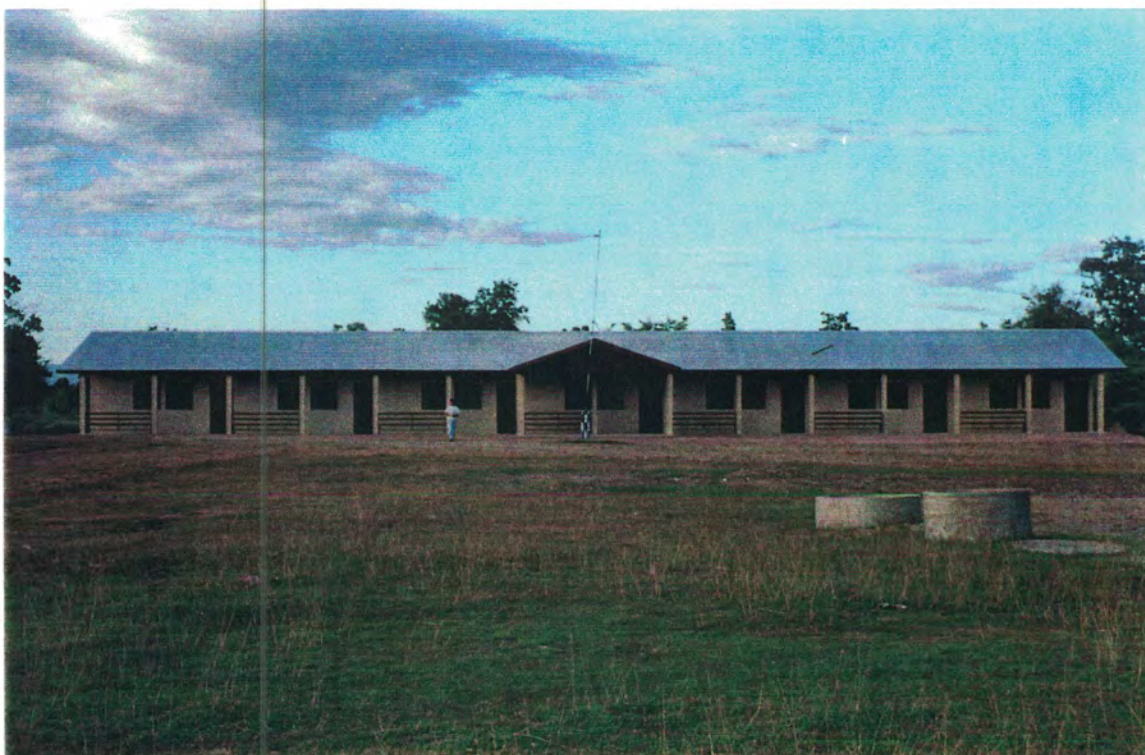

PROJECT TITLE: BAKER LEADER VII

UNIT: 1st Plt, B Co, 84th Engineer Bn (C)(H)

PROJECT SITE: Khong Island, Laos

DESCRIPTION: 131'x 40' seven room school house building constructed of wood and concrete masonry block. Corrugated roofing from the U.S. was used for the first time.

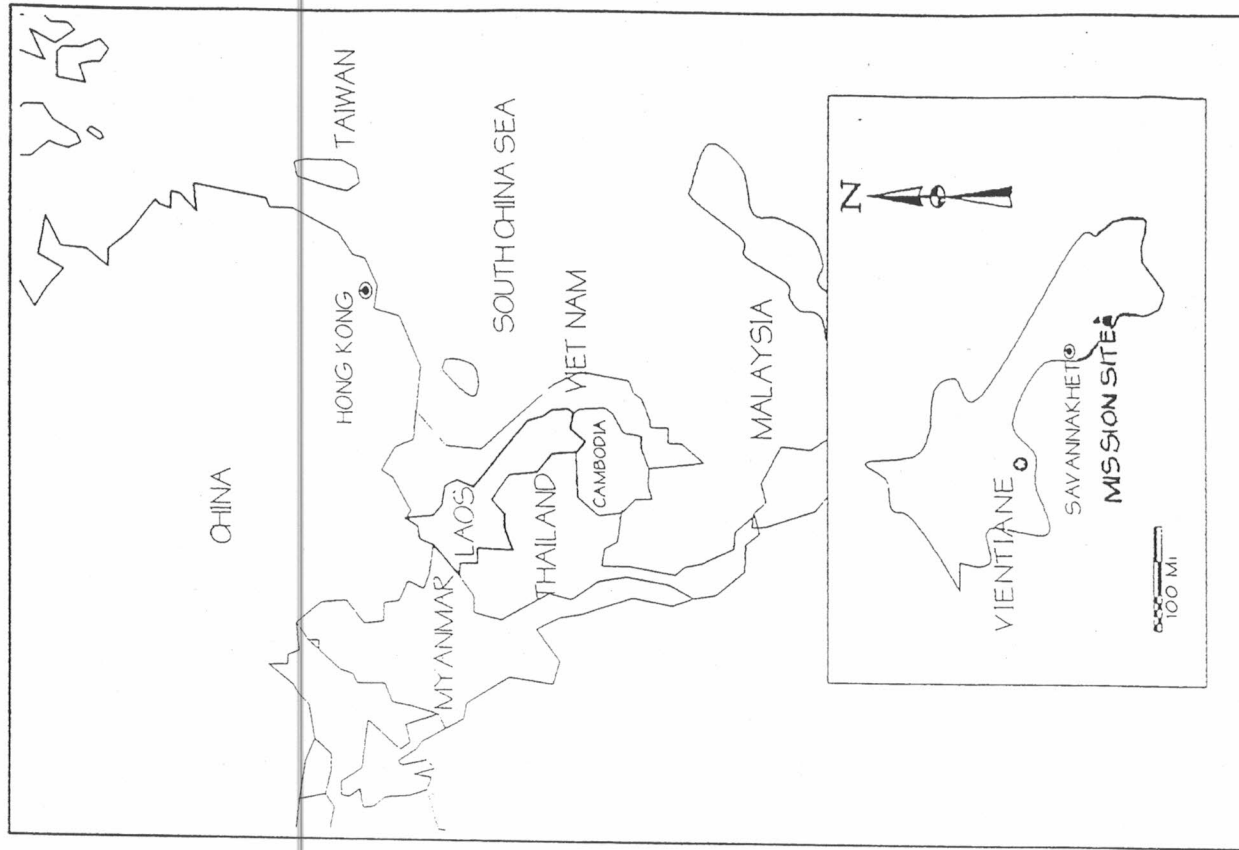

REMARKS: This site is about 5 KM from Cambodia. Built along side a half completed school started by the American Military in the Mid 1970's. The bulk of the materials and equipment were transported by boat on the Mekong River.

DESCRIPTION: 131'x 40' seven room school house building constructed of wood and concrete masonry block. School design features a porch, benches, and latrines for the first time.

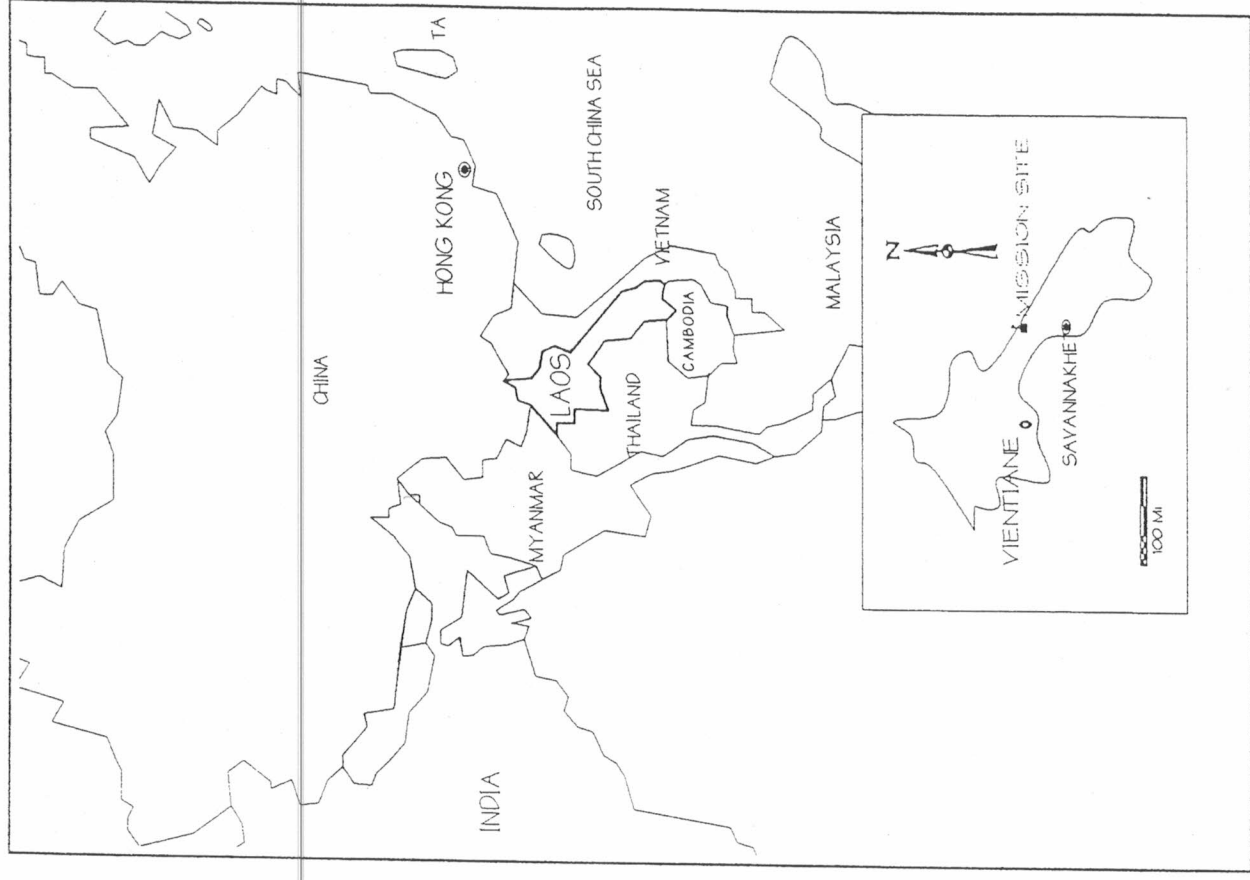

REMARKS: This school is built along the Ho Chi Minh Trail in the most remote location of any of the schools built to date.

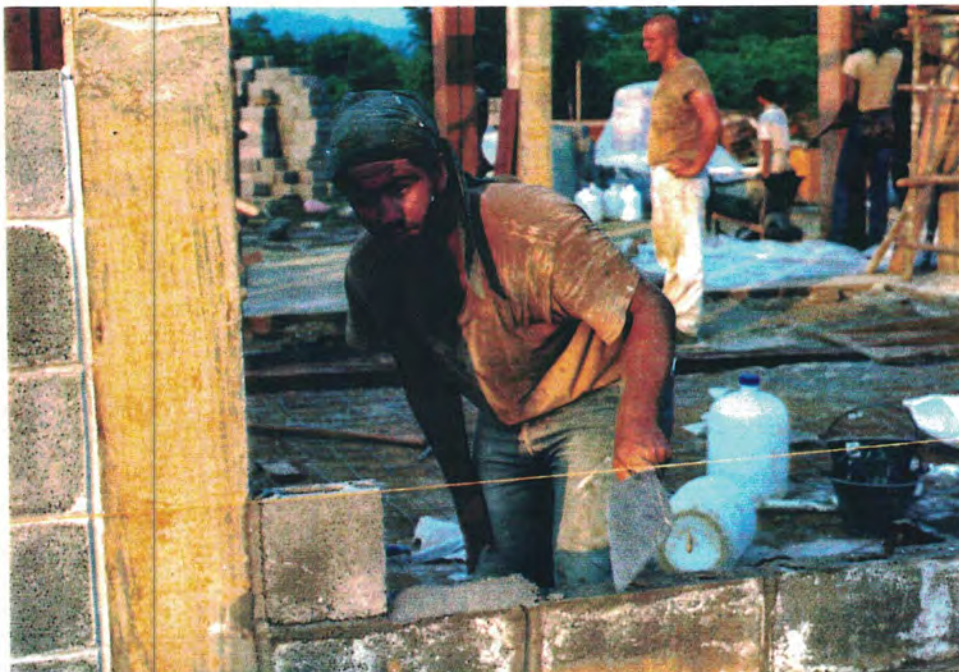




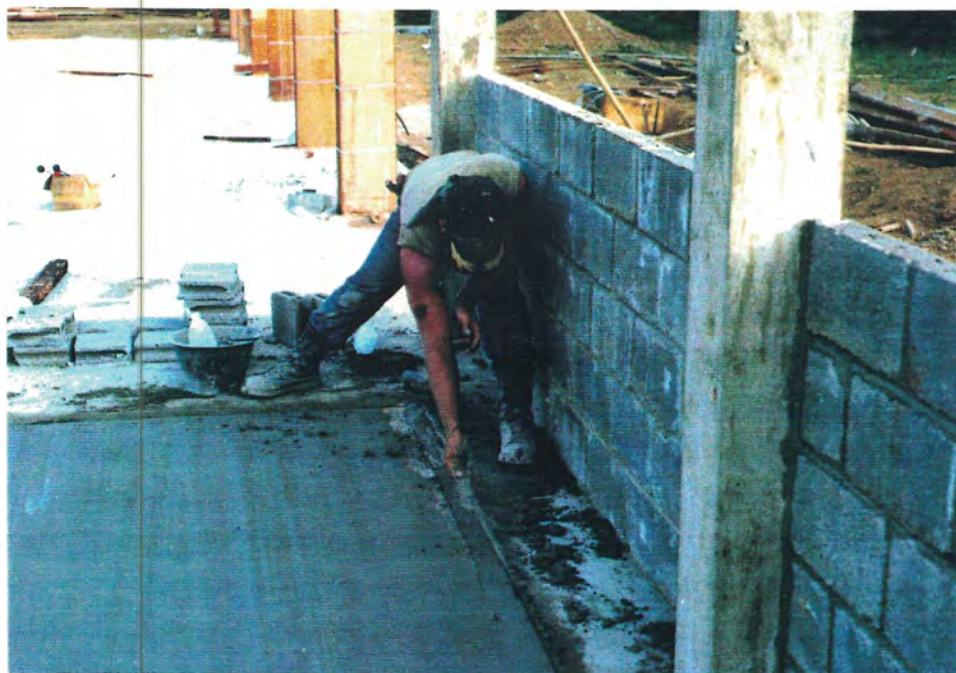

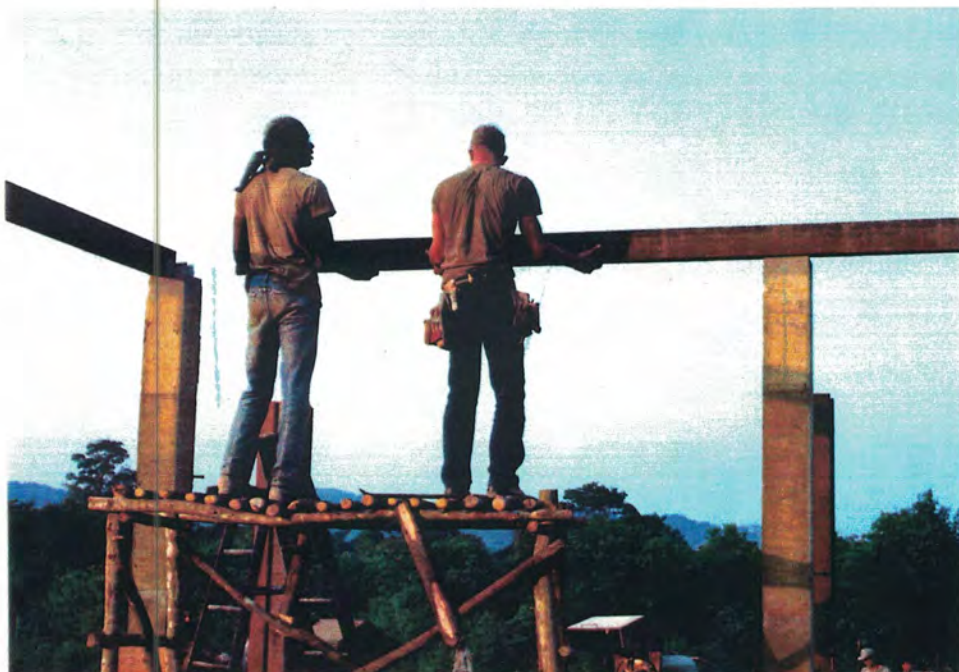

PROJECT SITE: Kosrae, Federated States of Micronesia

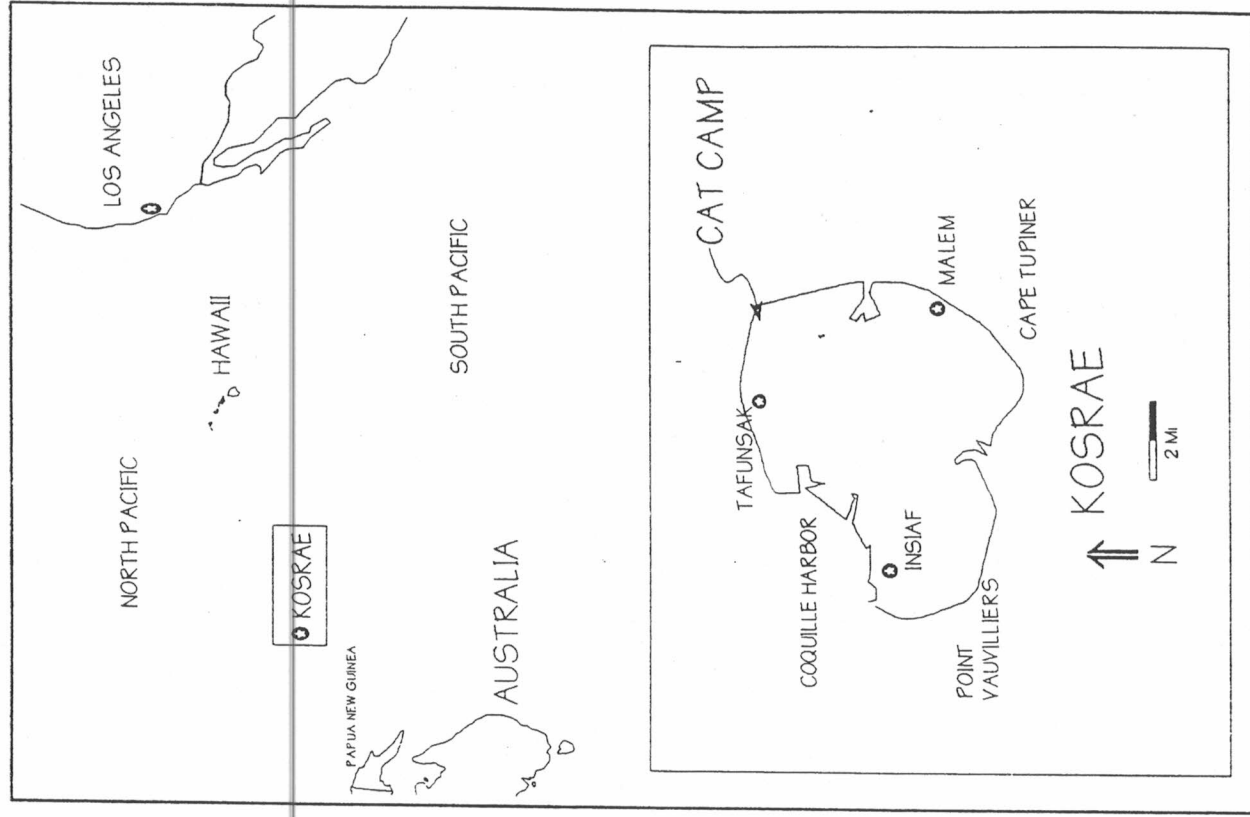
DESCRIPTION: Assist in the development of the island's socio-economic infrastructure.

START DATE: 1 Apr 93

COMPLETION DATE: 27 Sep 93

ESTIMATED COST: Shared funding by the Federated States of Micronesia and the United States Military.

REMARKS: Twelve soldier team augmented by one Special Forces Medic upgraded a farm road, extended an office building, installed a septic tank, maintained the plumbing of remote villages, constructed a basketball court, and a parking lot among other construction services for six months. Permanently manned site with new teams rotating in every six months.

PROJECT SITE: Kwajalein Atoll, Republic of the Marshall Islands

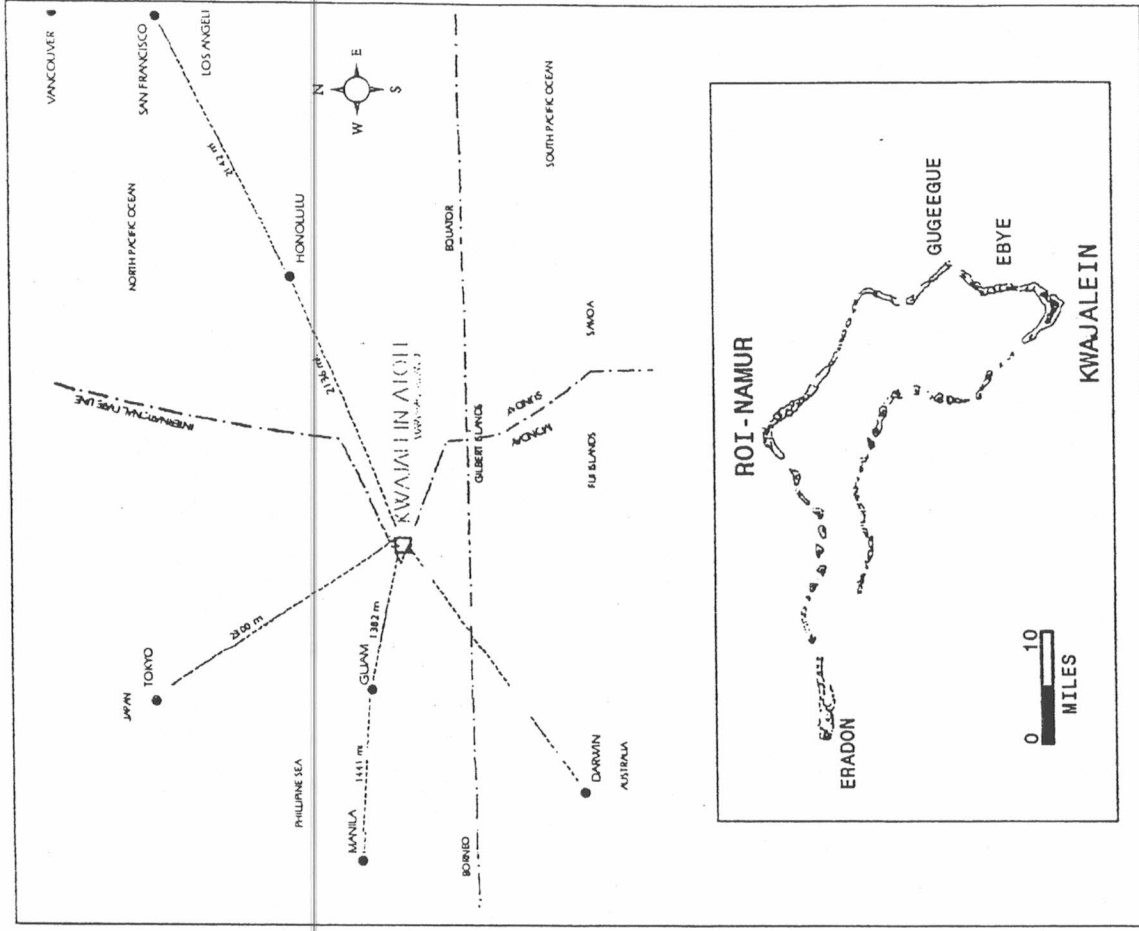
DESCRIPTION: Assist in the development of the island's socio-economic infrastructure.

START DATE: 4 May 93

COMPLETION DATE: 22 Oct 93

ESTIMATED COST: Shared funding by the Republic of the Marshall Islands and the United States Military.

REMARKS: Thirteen soldier team augmented by one Special Forces medic completed structural repairs on Ebeye Island, improved base camp facilities on Gugeegue Island, provided extensive medical support throughout Kwajalein Atoll, and assisted the people of Likiep Atoll with medical services and 3700 feet of airfield upgrade.

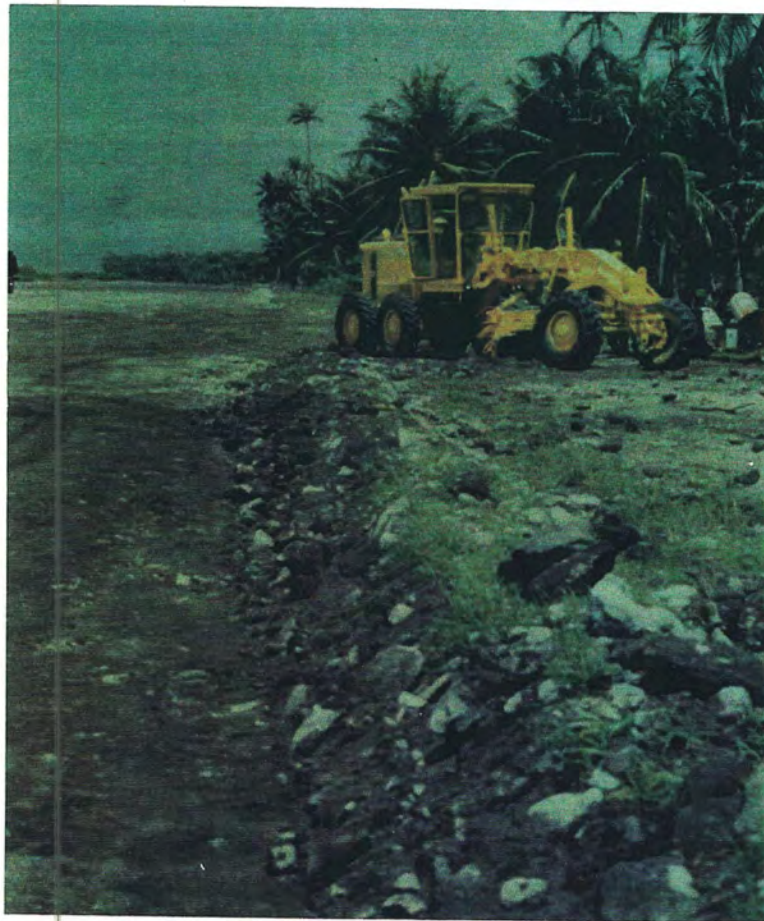

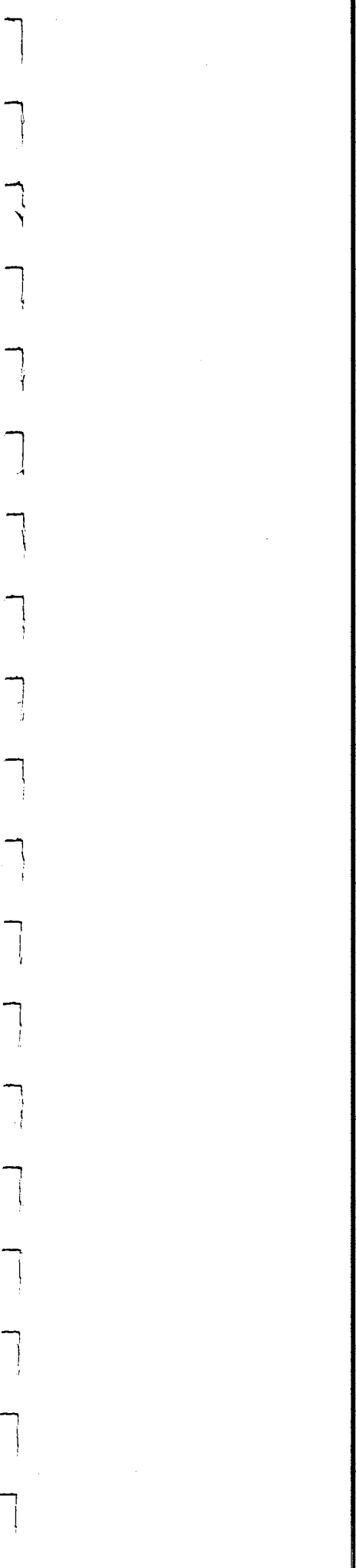

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PROJECT TITLE: GEORGE SEITZ ELEMENTARY SCHOOL

UNIT: 2nd Platoon, A Co, 84th Engineer Bn (C)(H)

PROJECT SITE: Kwajalein Atoll, Republic of the Marshall Islands

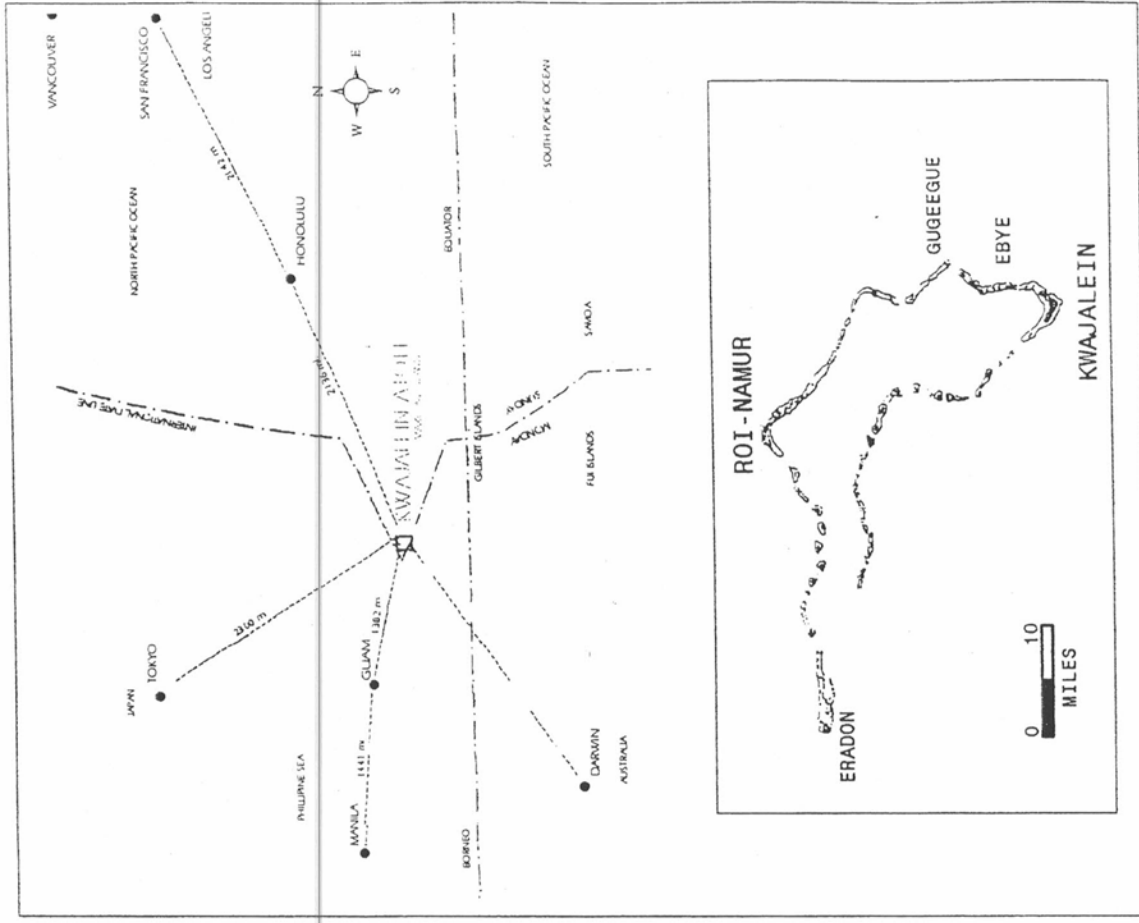
DESCRIPTION: 5600 sf school building with four rooms classrooms and one storage room. Constructed of concrete masonry block and wood.

START DATE: 20 July 1993

COMPLETION DATE: 22 Nov 93

ESTIMATED COST: \$297,578 (renovations)
\$ 99,193 (new construction)

REMARKS: A 30 soldier platoon constructed the building, adjacent to an existing school built during a previous 84th Engineer Battalion (C)(H) deployment. This is the only primary school on the island and is used for American Dependents.

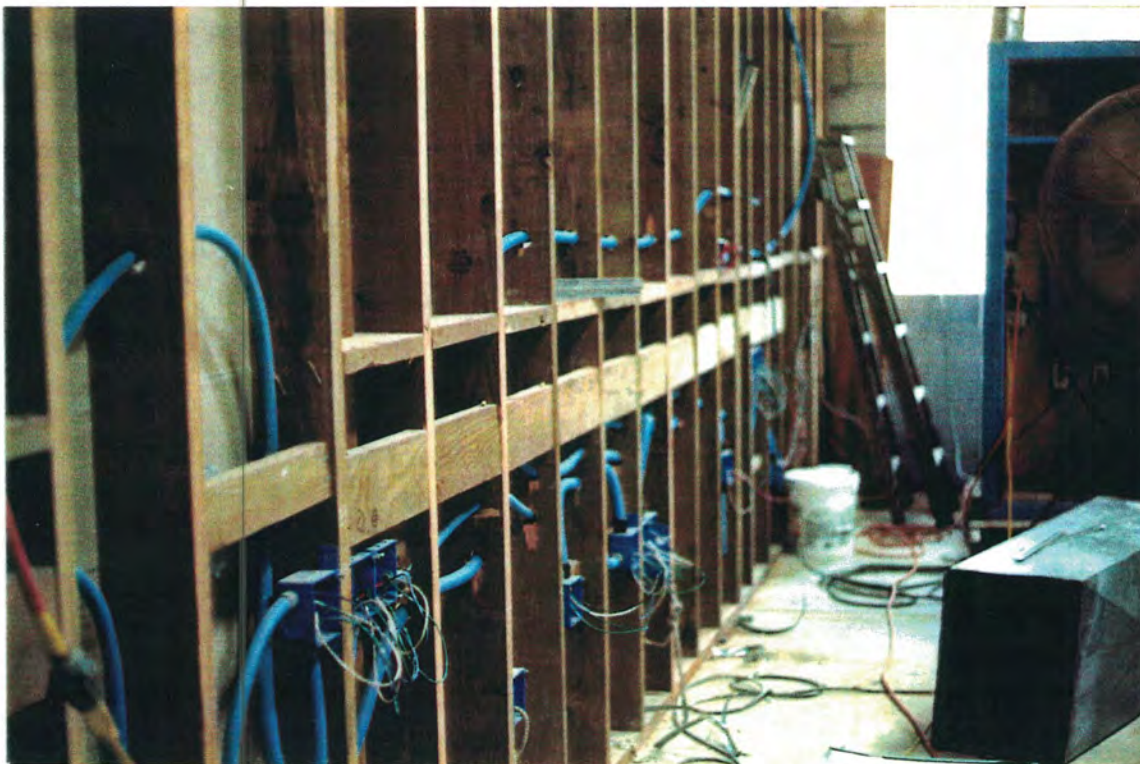

DESCRIPTION: 30' x 20' Medical clinic constructed of wood and concrete masonry block, 27' tall water tower, generator shed, septic tank, & 1100 gal water storage tank.

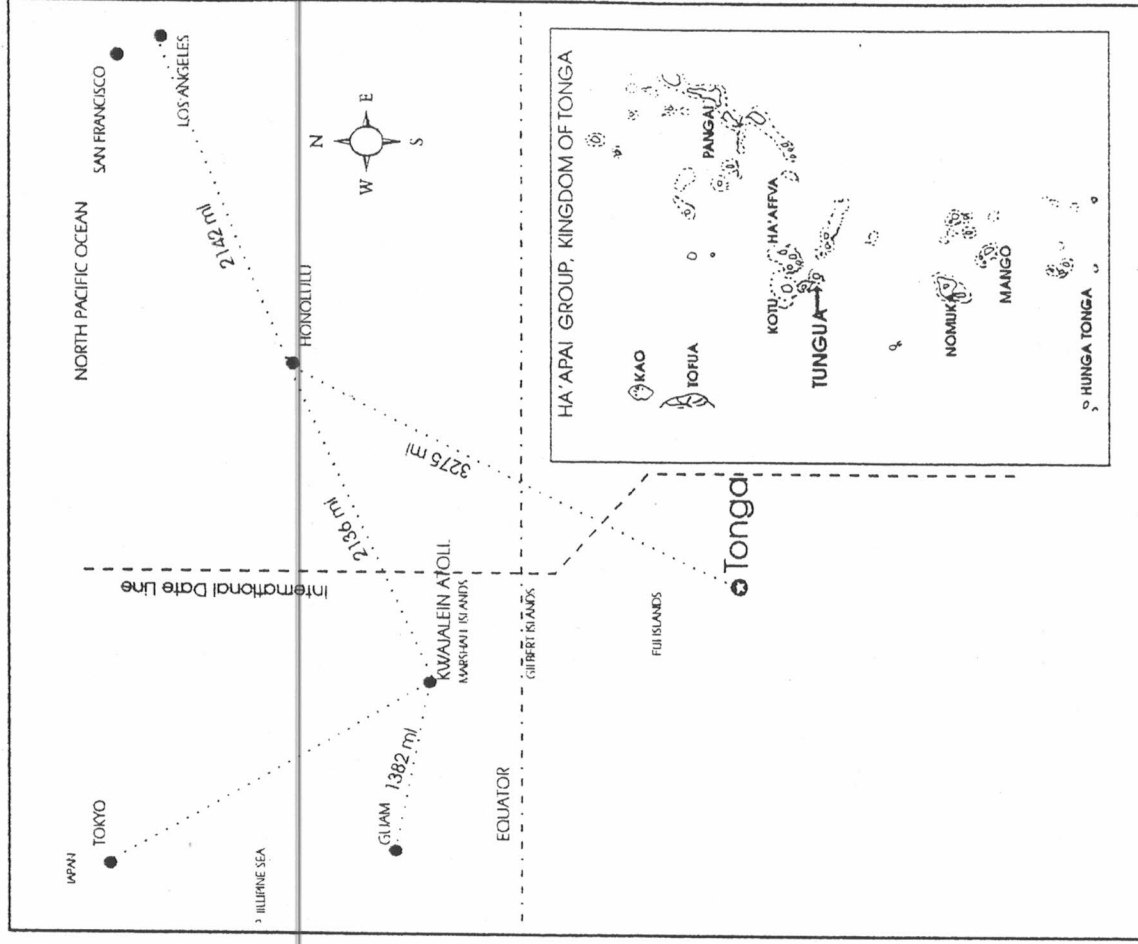

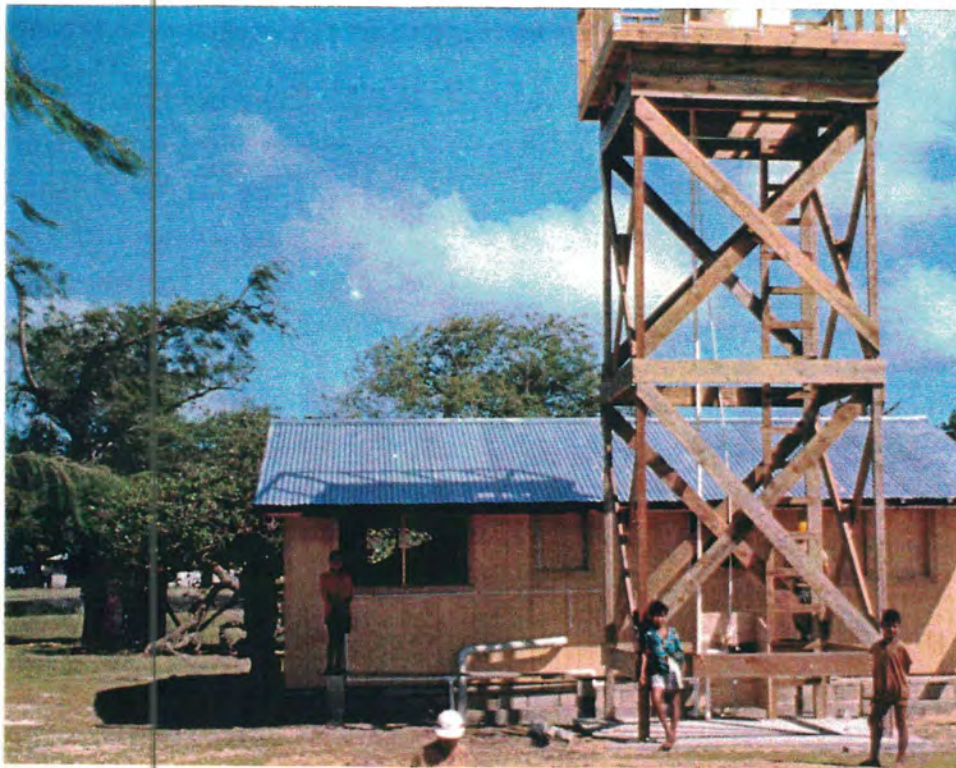
